

Community Meeting

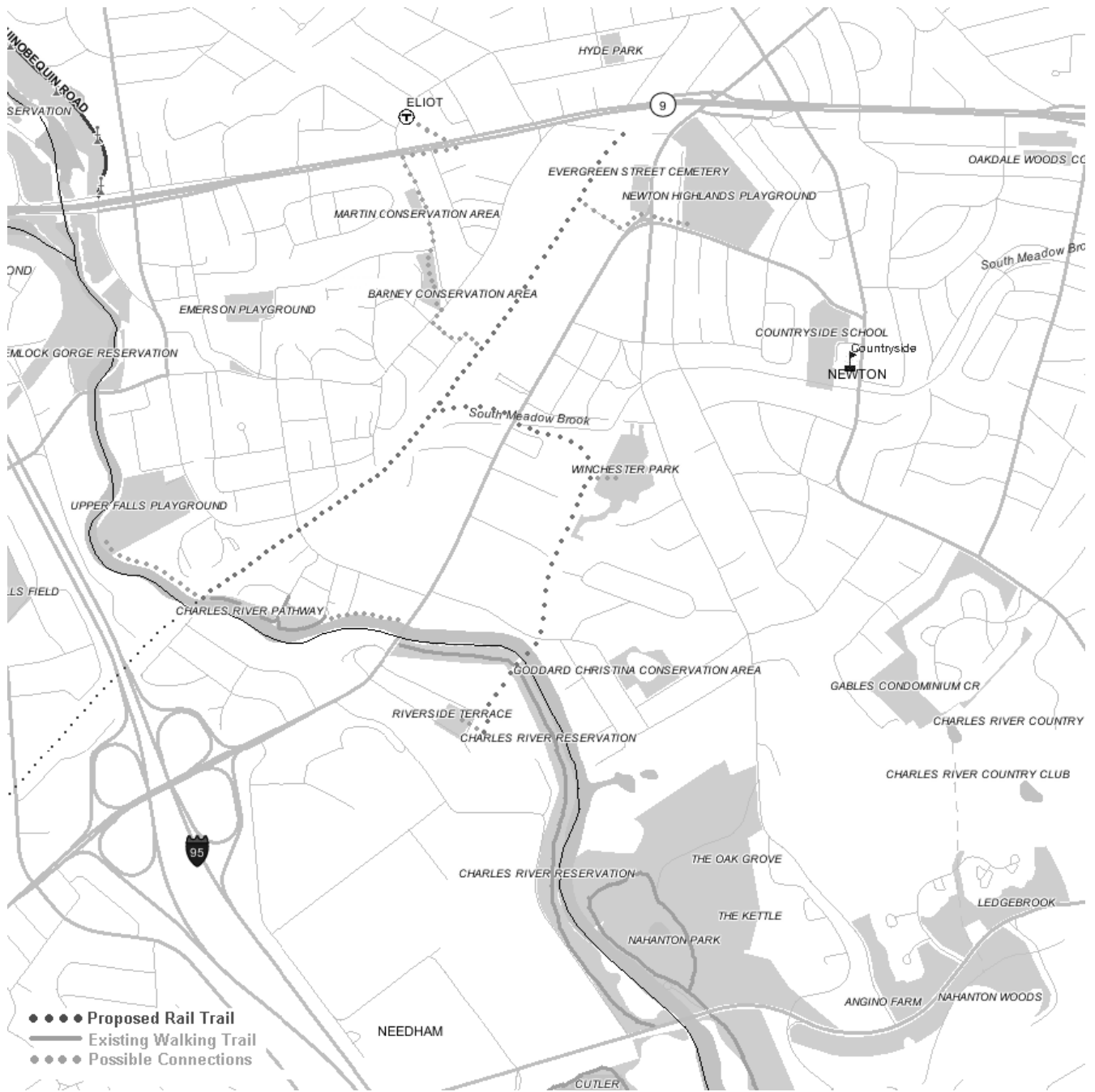
**Sunday April 10, 2pm at

followed by an optional walk along the proposed trail route

Come join a discussion about a proposal to convert the abandoned railroad tracks into a pedestrian and bicycle-friendly path. The tracks run roughly parallel to Needham St. from behind National Lumber, past Marshall's Plaza, across Oak St, and all the way to the Charles River. A spur of the tracks crosses Needham St., curves around behind the industrial buildings on the east side, and crosses the Charles river and the existing Charles River Pathway. We'll meet to discuss the possibilities, ask and answer questions, and then take a walk along the right of way, weather permitting. Please join us at the Emerson Community Center on Sunday April 10th at 2pm.
