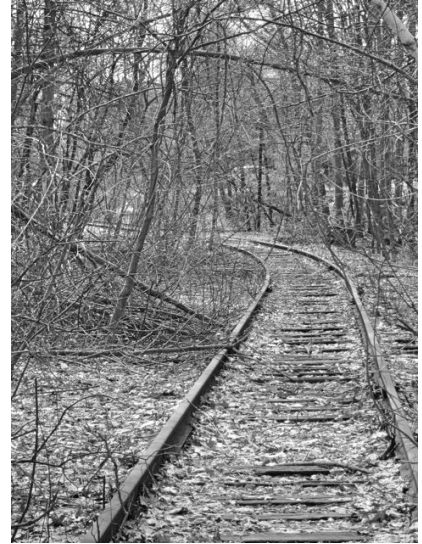


# Newton Upper Falls Community Meetings On a Rail Trail Greenway Path

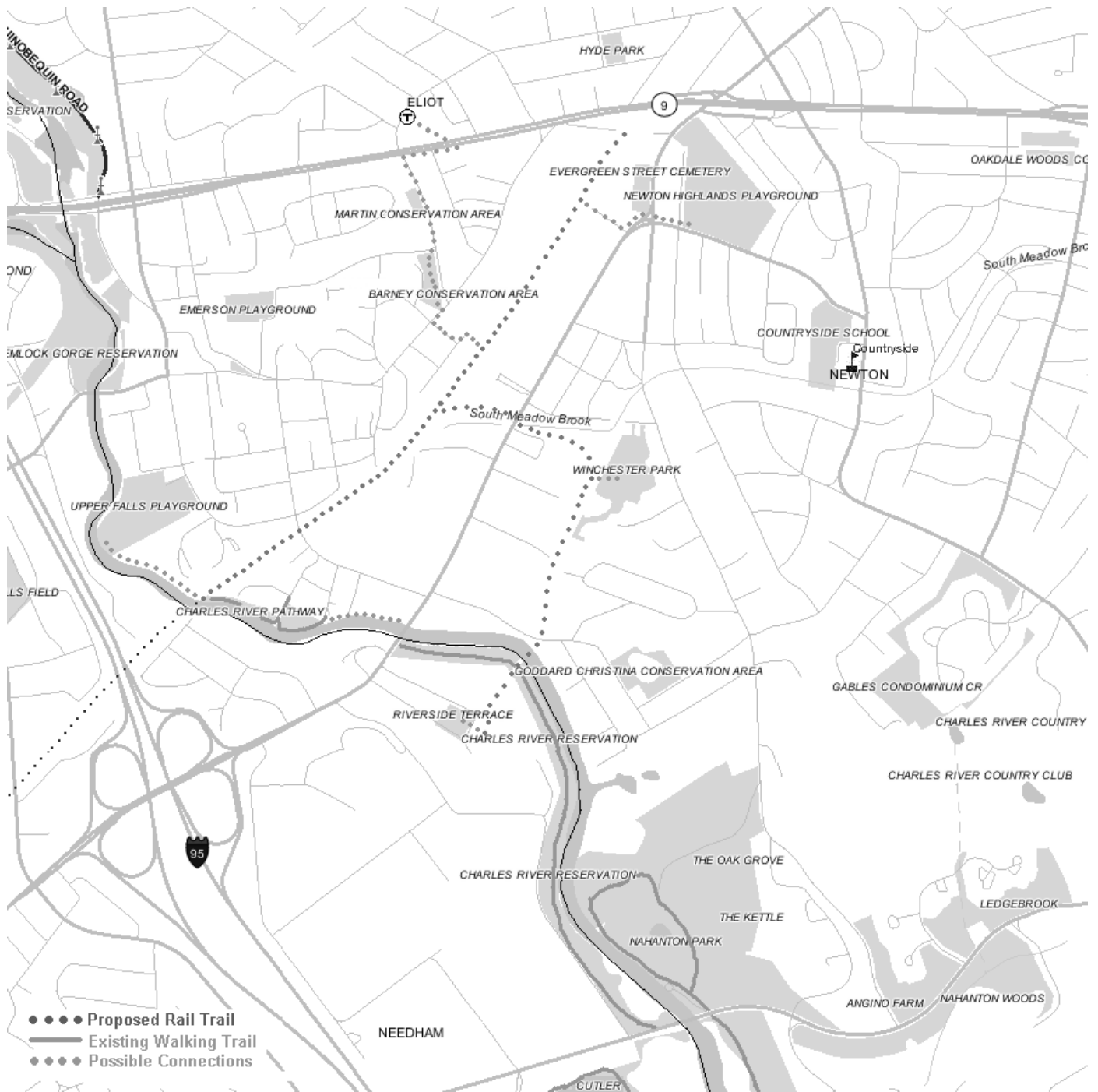
**Sundays, April 10<sup>th</sup> and May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2pm at  
Emerson Community Center, 1 Pettee St., Newton Upper Falls**  
followed by an optional walk along the proposed trail route

Come join a discussion about a proposal to convert the abandoned railroad tracks into a pedestrian and bicycle-friendly path. The tracks run roughly parallel to Needham St. from behind National Lumber, past Marshall's Plaza, across Oak St, and all the way to the Charles River. A spur of the tracks crosses Needham St., curves around behind the industrial buildings on the east side, and crosses the Charles River and the existing Charles River Pathway. See map on reverse side for the "rail trail" and other connecting paths.



We'll meet to discuss the possibilities, ask and answer questions, and then take a walk along the right of way, weather permitting. Please join us on either of two Sundays, April 10<sup>th</sup> and May 1<sup>st</sup>, at 2pm., meeting at the Emerson Community Center.
